Planted January 2024

122 Burren pines were planted on this site along with 366 native companion species such as alder, birch, hawthorn, holly, oak, spindle and hazel in January 2024 with the help of BCA staff, students, volunteers, and Burrenbeo Trust.

The ID numbers on this map relate to Burren pine trees only.

In Rectangle 1: 72 Burren pines are planted in 12 rows of 6 trees each.

In Rectangle 2: 50 Burren pines are planted in 5 rows of 10 trees each.

30 of the Burren pine trees (BP8091 to BP8120) have been sponsored by the Burren College of Art to mark the 30th anniversary of the college.
